What if -


What if they start to challenge your role, judgement and credibility (you hear a rumour they are talking about you) What if they openly challenge your decision making and leadership?

Do you have an ego? Clarity of roles is essential, how will you make this clear? Where do you get your credibility from?


Reflection -

How do you manage relationships? How do you personally deal with challenge? How would you be describe your leadership style.

















The Trust Radar





Process of a Negotiation


